To the Members of the City of Coos Bay City Council:

We ask that you deny this application for rezoning. The Bay should remain a Natural Aquatic Site. We in Bandon, consider Coos Bay partners in our tourism and fishing industries. The Coos Bay Area is where we go for much of our shopping, culture, medical visits, and recreation. We are downwind from your area. So any air pollution is our problem as well as yours.

There is no public benefit to this project which will provide over 1000 temporary jobs and leave the Bay Area with a development nightmare of temporary housing, fluctuating rents and housing prices, and traffic pollution. The area will be left with 57 permanent jobs, some of which will be held by Canadians with the skills to operate an LNG plant.


The union to which operators of such plants belong cautions against placing these plants in populated areas, let alone on an earthquake prone subduction zone.

The pipeline, crossing 400 bodies of water in Oregon's Rogue Valley and pristine wooded and agricultural privately owned properties, is another issue.
