

Public Comment on the Jordan Cove Energy Project (Land Use Application #187-18-000153)


Dear Members of the City of Coos Bay City Council,

Pembina has not met the requirements in order to be issued a permit by the City of Coos Bay. The proposed dredging does not comply with the Coos Bay Estuary Management Plan, City of Coos Bay Comprehensive Plan, and Statewide Planning Goal 16 Estuarine Resources. The Lane Council of Governments provided a thorough analysis with a recommendation to deny the application yet the Planning Commission approved forwarding the application for council review.

Specifically, I am concerned about the following impacts:

- SHORT AND LONG-TERM ECONOMIC BENEFIT IN LIGHT OF A DECREASING MARKET VALUE FOR ~~LNG~~ LNG.
- SHORT AND LONG-TERM ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS, WHICH HAS SHOWN TO-DATE TO BE UNQUESTIONABLY NEGATIVE.
- DECLINE IN REAL ESTATE HOME VALUES
- DEVASTATING AND CATASTROPHIC CONSEQUENCES SHOULD A TSUNAMI OCCUR, WHICH WOULD RESULT IN THE RELEASE OF DESTRUCTIVE LNG
- HEALTH RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION / IMPLEMENTATION / DECOMMISSIONING OF THE LNG PLANT
