RESOLUTION NO 16-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COOS BAY, COOS COUNTY, OREGON, CALLING A MEASURE ELECTION TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS THE QUESTION OF SHALL THE CITY OF COOS BAY ADOPT A 4 CENT PER GALLON FUEL TAX DEDICATED TO STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Coos Bay, Coos County, Oregon (the "City"), has determined that a need exists to fund the costs of capital construction and maintenance of city streets (Projects); and

WHEREAS, the summary of the ballot measure provides:

A "yes" vote approves creation of funding dedicated to street maintenance and repair through a 4 cent per gallon tax on motor vehicle fuels sold in Coos Bay. The tax is estimated to raise \$300,000 annually, and it will only be used for street repairs and maintenance. Funds collected by this tax will not be used for other street related improvements such as sidewalks, traffic signs, traffic signals, or city maintenance staff.

Vehicles subject to "weight-mile tax" (trucks over 26,000 pounds not required to pay diesel fuel tax) or having a "use fuel" (approved PUC tax exempt for diesel, propane, CNG or other fuel that is not gasoline) certificate will be exempt from the tax.

The City of North Bend has proposed the same motor vehicle fuels tax measure. If passed by the electorate, Coos Bay's fuels tax measure will be implemented only upon passage by North Bend of its fuels tax measure.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Coos Bay, Coos County, Oregon, that:

A. A measure election is hereby called for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City the question of Shall the City of Coos Bay adopt a 4 cent per gallon fuel tax dedicated to street maintenance and repair.

B. The measure election hereby called shall be held on the 8th day of November, 2016.

C. The City authorizes the City Manager, Finance Director, or the designee of either of those officials (each an "Authorized Representative") to act on behalf of the City and to take such further action as is necessary to carry out the intent and purposes herein in compliance with the applicable provisions of law.

D. Pursuant to ORS 250.275(5) and 250.296 the City Elections official shall publish the ballot title, by August 25, 2016, in The World or in some other newspaper of general distribution within the City, a notice of receipt of the ballot title including notice that a dissatisfied registered voter may file a petition with the Circuit Court for review of the ballot title not later than the seventh business day after the ballot title is filed in substantially the form of Exhibit B.

E. Pursuant to ORS 254.095 the City Elections official will deliver a Notice of City Measure Election in substantially the form of Exhibit A to the Coos County Elections Office.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Coos Bay, Coos County, Oregon, this 16th day of August 2016.
