



**City of Coos Bay
Addendum No. 1 to the
Request for Proposals
To Provide Engineering Services
For Wastewater Treatment Plant 2
SBR & MBR Comparison**

The following changes are made part of the request for proposals document for Engineering Services for Wastewater Treatment Plant 2 SBR & MBR Comparison.

Clarifications:

1. The cover letter is included in the eight maximum pages. Additional information may be included in an appendix, but may not be considered by all reviewers. The intent is to keep the proposals short and simple.
2. The RFP asks for the effluent quality only. If the successful proposer wants to include a brief section of the actual impact of that effluent on the water quality of the bay, it would be a great addition to the report, but not required.
3. The requirement for three references “specifically associated with SBR and MBR treatment” may include experience in design and construction, modification, value engineering, facilities planning evaluation, or operation of such plants. For the purposes of this proposal, Tribal facilities above 0.3 MGD dry weather flow will count as “local government jurisdictions”.

Changes to the Request for Proposals

The following changes are incorporated into the Request for Proposals to Provide Engineering Services for Wastewater Treatment Plant 2 SBR & MBR Comparison:

Page 2: References:

Add: “and/or Washington” directly after “Oregon”.

Page 3: Proposal Package Requirements:

Add: “5. **Request for Indemnification:** Proposer may at their option attach a clause to the agreement whereby the City indemnifies the successful proposer against a lawsuit relating to the final report and recommendation. Such clause is subject to review and approval of the City Attorney and does not count as part of the proposal page limit.”

Page 5: Minimum Qualifications:

Delete “, Design Build Operate, Design Build Finance Operate, and Design Build Operate Own” and replace with “and Design Build”.

Clarification: “Affiliation” in the context of this proposal means that the proposer is not currently working on a proposal or design for WWTP2 with the listed firms and that any prior or current

contact and relationship with the listed firms is not such that it would influence the recommendations made by the proposers to the City in the final report.

Page 6: Resources to be Provided

GE Power and Water has prepared a membrane equipment cost and basin requirement proposal for the City, which is available by contacting Chris Allen at Chris.Allen@ge.com.

Beaver Equipment Company, a rep for Sanitaire, has prepared an SBR equipment cost and basin requirement proposal for the City, which is available by contacting Ken Black at kenb@beaver-equipment.com.

Page 7: Replace existing schedule with the following:
