Force main	A wastewater pipe that is pressurized, unlike ordinary gravity-flow sewer lines.					
Slurry filling	A method of filling an abandoned sewer pipe. Wet slurry fills the pipe and is left to solidify.

Additional notes *

Pump Station 1, Pump Station 16 Pump Station 1's aging pumps and generator need increasingly frequent repair, and replacement parts are costly and difficult to obtain. Leaks in the deteriorating building are further damaging the equipment. Because PS1 is the city's largest-capacity pump station, a failure could cause a sewer overflow. Its priority has been moved up, delaying the PS16 project one year.
