ISSUE Library Services and Technology Grants

BACKGROUND

The State Library of Oregon administers Library Services and Technology Grants each year. The purpose of the grants is to advance technology and access in libraries. The Coos Bay Public Library applied and received a grant to develop a "Gadget Gallery". The idea behind the project is to purchase devices that are compatible with the downloadable content offered by the library. The devices will be used to train staff so they are more comfortable assisting patrons with the downloadable content. The devices will also be used in technology classes for the public. Even as technology advances, the basic skills learned will be transferable.

ADVANTAGES

The grant monies will allow the library to purchase items that are outside the abilities of the current budget.

DISADVANTAGES

The grant award was not foreseen at the time of the budget preparation. It will enhance the current budget.
