WHEREAS, 20% of children ages 0 to 17 in Coos County, Oregon are victims of abuse each year; and

WHEREAS, President Barack Obama has proclaimed the month of April as National Child Abuse Prevention Month; and

WHEREAS, the victory over child abuse and neglect will not be achieved without the support of the entire community and recognition of the importance of awareness raising to decrease incidents of abuse and support child abuse victims and their families; and

WHEREAS, each April the Child Abuse Intervention Center and other supporters of the Child Advocacy Movement ask the community to join the outreach efforts to reduce and prevent child abuse.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Crystal Shoji, Mayor of the City of Coos Bay, hereby proclaim April 2013 to be

CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS MONTH

in the City of Coos Bay, and encourage all citizens to join in a national effort to raise awareness and help prevent child abuse and neglect.
