ISSUE: **Bay Area Chamber of Commerce Semi-Annual Report**

BACKGROUND:

The Bay Area Chamber of Commerce (BACC) was established in 1980. It is a non-profit, professional organization made up of the Coos Bay, North Bend, and Charleston business communities.
