**ISSUE:** Set a public hearing to vacate a triangular portion of the city right-of-way (ROW)

southeast of the new location for the Coos Historical and Maritime Museum

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Community Development Department has received a request from the Coos Historical and Maritime Museum to vacate a triangular portion of the City Right-of-Way (ROW) southeast of the new location of the Coos Historical and Maritime Museum defined as:

The southwest corner of Lot 19, Block 65 in the Bennett's Addition to Marshfield;
Thence, traveling in a south easterly direction approximately 60 feet;
Thence, traveling 77 feet in a northerly direction;
Thence, traveling 50 feet in a south westerly direction to the point of beginning.

The applicant has secured the required two-thirds property owners signatures from adjacent properties. In order to proceed with the request, the City Council must set a date for the Planning Commission to hold the initial public hearing.

## <u>ADVANTAGE</u>

Processing the application will allow full consideration of the proposed vacation by the Planning Commission.
