ISSUE Public Hearing on the Use of State Revenue Sharing and Adoption of Resolution

BACKGROUND

The State of Oregon allocates 14 percent of state liquor receipts quarterly to Oregon cities based on a formula as outlined in ORS 221.770, better known as "state revenue sharing". The state distribution is in addition to the 20 percent of the state's liquor receipts allocated on a monthly basis. The 14 percent state revenue sharing is allocated on a formula basis that compares the city's consolidated property tax rate, per capita income and population against statewide averages. The City of Coos Bay received \$145,299 in state revenue sharing in fiscal year 2013 – 2014, budgeted to receive \$138,000 in 2014 – 2015, and budgeted to receive \$142,000 in 2015 – 2016. The following is a ten year history of actual disbursements to all Oregon cities.

In order to participate in the State Revenue Sharing Funds program a public hearing is required to be held before the Budget Committee and the City Council. A public hearing before the Budget Committee was held April 14, 2015. In accordance with ORS 221.770, a public hearing before the City Council has been scheduled and published for the purpose of taking public input on the use of State Revenue Sharing funds for June 2, 2015.

<u>ADVANTAGES</u>

By holding a hearing and adopting the resolution, it ensures the City is in compliance with ORS 221.770 and is eligible to receive State Revenue Sharing Funds for Fiscal Year 2015-16.

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DISADVANTAGES

None.

BUDGET

Adoption of the resolution provides notice to the state of the City's intent to participate in the State Revenue Sharing program.

It is staff's recommendation the City Council

- 1) Hold the public hearing and accept input in the use of State Revenue Sharing Funds, and
- 2) Adopt Resolution 15-11 to accept State Revenue Sharing funds.
