- <u>ISSUE:</u> Consideration of Approval to Award the Contract for Forestry Management Services for the City's 2016 Timber Sale to Stuntzner Forestry and Engineering, LLC

BACKGROUND:

On August 20, 2013, City Council awarded the contract for Forestry Management Services to Stuntzner Forestry and Engineering, LLC. The Contract is for two City timber sales. Additionally the contract shall also cover any additional services that are required, related to forestry management throughout the duration of the contract. The City has conducted one sale under the contract to date (2014 City Timber Sale).

City Staff has been working with Stuntzner on the upcoming 2016 City Timber Sale. Stuntzner has performed preliminary investigation and recommended three units for the upcoming sale comprising of 51 acres. If Stunzner's contract is approved, they will prepare a prospectus for this sale and advertise to bid in February.

ADVANTAGES:

Awarding the contract to Stuntzner will allow the City to conduct a timber sale.

DISADVANTAGES:

Staff sees no disadvantages with this recommendation.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:

During the investigation phase the City has expended \$6,025. To conduct the bid for the 2016 Timber Sale, manage the logging, procure seedlings, and bid and manage the plantings, Stuntzner's contract will need an additional \$51,235 for a total of \$57,260. A 10% contingency fee is recommended which will bring the total contract for forestry management services for the 2016 Timber Sale to \$62,986. The source of funds for this contract is the Fund 34, Major Capital Reserve Fund, Department 870, Timber Costs (34-870-520-2301).

ACTION REQUESTED:

If it pleases council, award the forestry management services contract for the City's 2016 Timber Sale to Stuntzner Forestry and Engineering, LLC for a fee not to exceed \$62,986. LAND SURVEYING

Re: 2016 Timber Management Activities

Dear Jennifer & Jessica,

We have identified a timber sale in the Pony Creek Watershed for a timber sale in 2016 that is consistent with the Watershed Management Plan and should meet your expectations. The sale consists of 3 units totaling 50.95 total acres on the Southeast side of the Libby Arm of Upper Pony Creek Reservoir: Stand 23 and a portion of stand 22 as shown in the Watershed Management Plan. The 3 units are as follows:

Unit 1 = 47.5 acres of Clear cut harvest Unit 2 = 1.39 acres of Leave Tree area Unit 3 = 2.06 acres of RMA (3 small areas of small fish bearing stream buffer)

The units are also shown on the attached map. As discussed at our pre-sale meeting, the sale location was chosen because we have harvested the last two sales on the Southwest side of Upper Pony Creek Reservoir and feel the need to alleviate pressure on any given area over a short period of time.

The proposed sale is estimated to be about 1.9 million board feet in size. We estimate the stumpage revenue to be in the range of \$540,000 to \$600,000. Unit 1 will require approximately 20 STA of new road construction. Rocking for this new road will be at the discretion of the buyer.

Two areas located on the North and South portions of the western edge of the Unit border the EIS buffer. The northern portion is very small and has been surveyed before. Existing flagging will be reflagged and used as the buffer. The Southern portion is located in the Leave Tree area and will not be near any harvest. This area is a Leave Tree area due to access issues but also will satisfy Oregon Department of Forestry requirements for leave trees. The

Leave Tree area will be available for harvest in the future. The 3 small fish bearing stream areas will have a 50 ft (on each side) no cut buffer flagged and painted. This area will not be cruised. The recent 2014 timber sale allowed 1 year and 8 months for timber removal and we would suggest a similar contract deadline for this sale.

While the Coos Bay China log export market has stabilized in the last 6 months, the domestic log market has remained the primary consumer. Also attached is a proposed maximum not to exceed fee and scope of work for the 2016 timber sale for your review.


