<u>ISSUE:</u> Supplemental Budget and Public Hearing Resolution 16-16 Street Improvement

and Gas Tax Fund

BACKGROUND:

During December 2015 storm events City property was damaged, specifically West Park Roadway, Coos River Highway, Empire Boat Ramp, Englewood dike, and other areas throughout the City. Since that time Public Works has been working with Federal and State agencies to coordinate reimbursement and the repairs. The reimbursements and projects were not budgeted in the FYE 16 budget and the appropriation authority needs to be adjusted to meet Oregon Budget law. The appropriation authority requested is a conservative estimate of the completed projects to ensure the expenditures do not exceed the respective revenues.

Pursuant to Oregon Budget Law, to appropriate funds by more than 10% of the fund's adopted expenditure total, a public hearing is required be to be held at a regularly scheduled meeting. The public hearing has been publicly noticed not less than five days before the meeting.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COOS BAY, COOS COUNTY, OREGON, PUBLIC HEARING AND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE STREET IMPROVEMENT AND GAS TAX FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Coos Bay has complied with the provisions of ORS 294.473 to appropriate funds to adjust one fund's expenditures by more than 10% of the fund's adopted expenditure total; a public hearing shall be held; the governing body at a regularly scheduled meeting shall adopt a supplemental budget by resolution stating the need, purpose, and amount of the appropriation; provide notice of the meeting by publishing not less than five days before the meeting; the notice includes a summary of the changes proposed; and

WHEREAS, the Street Improvement and Gas Tax Funds require an additional appropriation for the Federal and State funds to be received due to the storm damage throughout the City during the December 2015 storm event; and
