ISSUE: SET A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSAL TO VACATE THE PORTION

OF DIVISION AVENUE BETWEEN N. EMPIRE BLVD AND N. MARPLE STREET

### **SUMMARY:**

The Community Development Department has received an application from RAF Development of Laguna Hills, California to vacate the portion of Division Avenue between North Empire Blvd. and North Marple Street. The right-of-way in this portion of Division Avenue is platted 30-feet in width. Currently this portion of Division Avenue is not an open right-of-way.

In order to proceed with the request, per State law, the City Council must set a date for the Planning Commission to hold the initial public hearing. By the Council setting the date for the public hearing, staff can set a Planning Commission meeting date for their recommendation on the application. The recommendation will be sent to the Council for the final hearing and decision.
