ISSUE: 20<sup>th</sup> Street "NO PARKING" Request

**SUMMARY:**

20<sup>th</sup> Street is located in the Englewood community off California Ave. 20<sup>th</sup> Street is 18 ft. wide, which does not allow for curbside parking on both sides of the street. The street is not currently marked "NO PARKING". There are mail boxes on the west side of 20<sup>th</sup> Street, and nothing on the eastside of the road. Neighborhood is requesting "NO PARKING SIGNS" be installed on the eastside of 20<sup>th</sup> Street.



**ACTION REQUESTED:**

If it please council, authorize staff to install "NO PARKING SIGNS" along 20<sup>th</sup> Street corridor.

**BACKGROUND:**

20<sup>th</sup> street is located in the Englewood community off California Ave. 20<sup>th</sup> street is 18 ft. wide, which does not allow for curbside parking on both sides of the street. The street is not currently marked "NO PARKING". There are mail boxes on the west side of 20<sup>th</sup> Street, and nothing on the eastside of the road. Neighborhood is requesting "NO PARKING SIGNS" be installed on the eastside of 20<sup>th</sup> Street.

Abutting neighbors on 20<sup>th</sup> Street request "NO PARKING SIGNS" be installed on 20<sup>th</sup> Street because the street is very narrow (18 ft.) and currently vehicles park on both sides of the street which makes it difficult to negotiate down the street or be difficult for an emergency service vehicle to get through.
