Abutting neighbors on 20th Street request "NO PARKING SIGNS" be installed on 20th Street because the street is very narrow (18 ft.) and currently vehicles park on both sides of the street which makes it difficult to negotiate down the street or be difficult for an emergency service vehicle to get through.
