ISSUE Public Hearing on the Use of State Revenue Sharing and Adoption of Resolution

SUMMARY

In order to participate in the Oregon State Revenue Sharing program a public hearing is required to be held before the Budget Committee and the City Council. A public hearing before the Budget Committee was held April 13, 2017. In accordance with ORS 221.770, a public hearing before the City Council has been scheduled and published for the purpose of taking public input on the use of State Revenue Sharing funds for June 6, 2017.

ACTION REQUESTED

It is staff's recommendation the City Council

- 1) Hold a public hearing and accept input in the use of State Revenue Sharing funds, and
- 2) Adopt Resolution 17-11 to accept State Revenue Sharing funds.

BACKGROUND

The State of Oregon allocates 14% of state liquor receipts quarterly to Oregon cities based on a formula as outlined in ORS 221.770, better known as "state revenue sharing". The state distribution is in addition to the 20% of the state's liquor receipts allocated on a monthly basis. The 14% state revenue sharing is allocated on a formula basis that compares the city's consolidated property tax rate, per capita income and population against statewide averages. The City of Coos Bay received \$150,903 in 2015, \$145,457 in 2016; and budgeted to receive \$151,000 in 2017 and 2018.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Adoption of the resolution provides notice to the State of Oregon of the City's intent to participate in the State Revenue Sharing program.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COOS BAY, COOS COUNTY, OREGON

WHEREAS, State Revenue Sharing Law, ORS 221.770, requires cities to pass an ordinance or resolution each year stating that they elect to receive state revenue sharing money; and

WHEREAS, the required Budget Committee public hearing was held on April 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the required City Council public hearing was held on June 6, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Coos Bay elects to receive state revenues for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.
