ISSUE: Award Construction Contract for the Sanitary Sewer Replacement West of WWTP No. 1 and the N. 4th Street/Highland Avenue

SUMMARY:

The City has bundled two smaller projects in an effort to obtain more competitive bids. The projects are titled, *Sanitary Sewer Replacement West of WWTP No. 1* and, *N. 4th Street/Highland Avenue Sewer Replacement*. HGE Inc was the design engineer for both projects. The Sanitary Sewer Replacement West of WWTP No. 1 is located along the west side of the wastewater treatment plant (680 Ivy Avenue) and consists of the replacement of approximately 430 feet of sanitary and 200 feet of storm sewer. The N. 4th street/Highland Avenue Sewer Replacement consists of approximately 260 feet of sanitary sewer replacement along N. 4th Street between Highland and Park Avenue and approximately 200 feet of sanitary sewer replacement along Highland Avenue between N. 4th and 3rd Street. Bids were opened on June 20, 2016. Two bids were received and accepted:

Johnson Rock Products, Inc.	\$456,653.50
Billeter Marine, LLC	\$335,793.72

Engineer's Estimate = \$315,829

The Sanitary Sewer Replacement West of WWTP No. 1 project is identified on the 20-year takedown list and the 5-year Capital Improvement Project (CIP) plan. The project is funded through the Infrastructure Finance Authority Loan Number 1 (Fund 2-810-530-3015). The N. 4th Street/Highland Avenue Sewer Replacement project is identified on the 5-year CIP plan and is an emergency project that was identified through a video investigation (29-810-530-3010). Due to the nature of underground work and the potential unknowns it is recommended that a 15% contingency be approved.

ACTION REQUESTED:

If it pleases the Council, award the construction contract to Billeter Marine, LLC for Sanitary Sewer Replacement West of WWTP No. 1 and the N. 4th Street/Highland Avenue Sewer Replacement Projects for a total project cost not to exceed \$386,162 (\$335,793.72 plus a 15% contingency of \$50,368.28).
