Mayor Benetti opened the meeting and led the assembly in the salute to the flag.

Recommendation to Approve the Annual Renewal of OLCC Licenses

The following annual renewals of OLCC licenses were recommended for approval: Bassett-Hyland Energy Company, Bi-Mart Corp., Boondox, Inc. dba Benetti's Italian Restaurant, G.P.F, Inc, dba Coos Bay Grocery Outlet, Englewood Market, Fred Meyer Stores, Inc., Ku, Chung N. dab Sumin's Restaurant, Taegu Foods, LCC, dba Kumyon's Restaurant, McKay's Market of Coos Bay [149 S. Central], McKay's Market of Coos Bay [130 N. Cammann], Thrifty Payless, Inc. dba Rite Aid, Lund Enterprises, Inc. dba Silver Dollar Tavern, Smith's Bayway Market, Red Lion Inn, Wal-Mart Stores, Inc., and Wanda's.

Mayor Benetti stated a conflict of interest due to his business OLCC license being considered. Councilor Stufflebean moved approve the OLCC renewals as presented. Councilor McKeown seconded the motion which passed with all Councilors present voting aye.

Consideration of Adoption of Resolution 05-05 Increasing Sewer User Rates

Mayor Benetti commented the rate increase was discussed at the Budget Committee meeting. Administrative Assistant Susanne Baker reported the increase will adjust the average household two to three dollars a month and will be used to fund construction capital projects. Councilor Stufflebean moved to adopt Resolution 05-05, which is attached hereto and made a part of thereby, increasing the sewer user rates, charges and fees. Councilor Miller seconded the motion which passed with the Mayor and all Councilors present voting aye.

City Manager's Report

City Manager Scott McClure reported the Fire Department did a burn to learn last Saturday and he participated in the training. He further commented it was interesting to learn about the
