The Department

The Coos Bay Police Department currently employs 23 sworn law enforcement personnel, including a Chief of Police, 2 Captains, 1 Detective Supervisor, 1 Detective, 4 Patrol Supervisors, 13 Patrol Officers and 1 School Resource Officer. In the Communications center there are 2 Communications Supervisors and 7 Telecommunicators, our records department has 1 Records supervisor and 2 Clerical Specialists.

The Coos Bay Police Department has a strong reputation for ethics and service and is well respected in the community. Community policing and crime prevention are priorities with a goal of maintaining a high level of public contact and resolution of issues before they become problems.

Position Benefits Base Pay - \$3,774-\$4,813 per month

Lateral applicants would be eligible for a \$5,000 hiring bonus (\$2,500 after being hired and \$2,500 after successful completion of probationary period, as well as the possibility of up to \$1,000 moving expense reimbursement.

Additional Incentive Pay

Possession of DPSST Intermediate Certification – \$163.30 per month Possession of DPSST Advanced Certification - \$283.37 per month Bilingual compensation – additional 5% of monthly base pay Longevity compensation – additional 2.5% - 7% of monthly base pay based on years of service. Education Incentive – AA/AS 2% BA/BS 5% of monthly base pay

Deferred Compensation – employees may contribute to a 457 Deferred Compensation Plan with any of four programs currently offered.

Health Insurance – The City participates in a Health Saving Plan, employees accruing \$4,000 at the beginning of the year. Additional benefits include dental and vision insurance.

Life and Long Term Disability Insurance – the City provides long term disability and life insurance policy.

Holidays – employees receive eleven paid holidays each year. Additional pay is offered to employees required to work any "named" holiday.

Fitness Club Membership - provided at no cost to employee.

Retirement - City is a PERS employer and pays employee's 6% contribution as well as the employer's contribution.
