

# Do you ever get the impression that no one's listening at City Hall?

If you've called City Hall this week, you may have noticed that your call did not go through or the department answering the phone was not the department you thought you called. City Hall has been undergoing a technology update this week, and the phones lines have been impacted. The City uses a voice-over-

internet-protocol (VOIP) system rather than the hard copper wired land lines that were once the only way to receive telephone service. The technology upgrade currently being undertaken is still ongoing, and it will replace components of the internal infrastructure of the City's network. It will correct the interwoven computer services provided by the City through City Hall.

We appreciate your patience, and we want to reassure you that once the upgrade is complete, the phone system and other computer networking components will be more reliable and efficient. Sometimes we have to slow down to speed up.
