# **Fireworks Safety**

Promote & Practice the 4 BE'S

### BE PREPARED:

- Store fireworks out of children's reach.
- -Always read and follow label directions.
- -Place pets indoors; they are easily frightened by fireworks.
- -Always have water handy
   (a garden hose or a bucket
- of water).



## BE SAFE:

- -An adult should always light fireworks.
- -Keep matches & lighters away from children.
- -Use fireworks outdoors only.
- -Light only one firework at a time & move away quickly.
- -Keep children & pets away from fireworks.
- -Always remember-do not throw fireworks or hold them in your hand.



### BE RESPONSIBLE:

- -Soak used fireworks thoroughly in a bucket of water.
- -Dispose of used fireworks & debris properly.
- -Never re-light "dud" fireworks. Wait 15-20 minutes then soak it in a bucket of water.

### BE AWARE:

- -Use only legal fireworks.
- -Use fireworks only in legal places.
- -Fireworks are prohibited on all beaches, State Parks, & State or Federal Forest lands.
