COOS BAY POLICE LOG PUBLISHED ON INTERNET – In what may be a first for law enforcement agencies, the Coos Bay Police Department public log is now posted each morning to the Internet. Persons with Internet access may go on-line to view police department activity in Coos Bay. The log is extracted from the police department's dispatch database, and then remotely uploaded to the Internet. The updates are currently posted around 6:00 in the morning daily. Confidential information is not included in the public log in order to protect the integrity of ongoing investigations.

Chief Chuck Knight sees the police log posting on the Internet as a way of enhancing communication between the police department and the community. He also cites the public's right to know what the police are doing as an additional benefit to the community.
