ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR STREET NAMING AND NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO, 2026.

The City of Coos Bay does ordain as follows:

- **Section 1. Uniform System.** All streets shall be named and all structures, except sheds and outbuildings, shall be numbered in accordance with this ordinance.
- **Section 2. Base Line.** Street names shall be established by Council resolution.
- **Section 3.** Authority to Assign Numbers. The Community Development Department shall assign numbers for all structures, except sheds and outbuildings, The owner or agent of any structure required by this ordinance to be numbered must apply to the Community Development Department for assignment of a number.
- **Section 4. Placing Numbers.** Owners of all existing structures that are required to be numbered shall comply within one month from the enactment of this ordinance, All structures erected after enactment of this ordinance are required to be numbered and must have numbers in place within one month after completion of the structure.

Section 5. Location and Type.

- (1) Numbers shall be affixed in a conspicuous location which is clearly visible from the fronting street and clearly identifies the structure.
- (2) Numbers shall be of contrasting color to the surface upon which they are affixed, They may be painted or metallic, plastic, or wooden fixtures that will not rust or corrode.
- (3) Numbers shall be at least three inches high.
- **Section 6. Penalty.** Violation of a provision of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of not more than \$25.00 for each day's violation.
- **Section 7.** Repeal. Ordinance No. 2026, passed August 24, 1959, is repealed,
