ORDINANCE NO. 227

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2706, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PEDESTRIAN MALL ON CENTRAL AVENUE BETWEEN THE WEST LINE OF FOURTH STREET AND THE EAST LINE OF FIFTH STREET, PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS PROHIBITING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON SUCH PEDESTRIAN MALL AND PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS THERETO; PROVIDING AN OPERATING DATE OF SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.
