ORDINANCE NO. 232

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 136, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 150, GRANTING TO FALCON CABLE SYSTEMS, A FRANCHISE FOR THE USE OF STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC EASEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF COOS BAY FOR THE OPERATION OF A CABLE TELEVISION COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM FOR A PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2004.

The City of Coos Bay ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. <u>Franchise</u>. The City of Coos Bay, herein called "City," grants Falcon Cable Systems Company II, L.P., herein called "Grantee," the right, privilege and franchise to erect, construct, operate and maintain in, under, upon and over the present and future streets, alleys and other public easements of the City, poles, wires, cable, underground conduits and all other necessary and convenient appurtenances, fixtures and equipment for the purposes of supplying television, radio and other cable communications services to the City and its inhabitants.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Council declares that an emergency exists and it is necessary for the general good that this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
