ORDINANCE NO. 278

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 124, AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PROTECTION OF STREETS IN THE CITY OF COOS BAY

The City of Coos Bay ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 1. Heavy Objects on Streets Prohibited is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a. No person shall operate any vehicle or move any building, structure, article or material having a net or gross weight greater than 15,000 pounds across or along any residential street, except state highways, unless the street is posted to allow grater weight and the moving object does not exceed the posted weight. Residential street means any street within an area not zoned commercial or industrial.
- b. (1) For the purpose of protecting the surface of the street, alley, roadway or other area, each owner or operator of a semi shall, at the time his or her semi trailer is parked on any city street, alley, roadway, or other area of city right-of-way which has been paved and is used for parking, place a board under the semi trailer landing gear, of sufficient length to span the feet of the landing gear, and of a width and thickness of not less than that provided by 2" x 6" dimensional lumber.

(2) Upon conviction, a fine of \$500.00 shall be imposed upon any owner or operator violating the terms of this subsection, along with an additional amount sufficient to cover the costs of restitution for repair of the city street, alley, roadway, or other area.

Section 2. Emergency Declared. The City Council of the City of Coos Bay finds that protection of streets, alley, roadways and other paved areas in the City of Coos Bay is a matter of the health, safety and welfare of the City of Coos Bay; therefore, the City Council hereby declares an emergency, and this ordinance shall have full force and effect from the time of its enactment and endorsement by the Mayor.
