

ORDINANCE NO. 293

ORDINANCE AMENDING COOS BAY LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE NO. 93, AS AMENDED, ADOPTING A DEFINITION FOR “HOMELESS SHELTER” AND LISTING THE USE IN THE “INDUSTRIAL-COMMERCIAL” ZONING DISTRICT THEREFOR

Coos Bay ordains as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1.8, Definitions, is amended to include the following definition:

Homeless Shelter: Any place or premise operated by a nonprofit organization wherein residence is provided to persons who need emergency shelter on a daily or weekly basis. Individual bath and cooking/eating facilities may or may not be provided.

Section 2. Chapter 2.11, Industrial / Commercial (I-C), Section 2(2), Permitted Uses, Residential Use Types, is amended to add the use, Homeless shelter.

Residential Use Types

Dwelling for caretaker, watchman, or housing directly required by the use.
Homeless shelter

Section 3. Emergency Declared. Because the prompt and continuous administration and enforcement of Ordinance No. 93 is necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Coos Bay, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
