ORDINANCE NO. 319

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING COOS BAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2000, VOLUME I, PART 1, PLAN POLICIES, CHAPTER 8.3, STRATEGIES, LU.1, AND TO VOLUME III, COOS BAY ESTUARY MANAGEMENT PLAN, PART 1, CHAPTER 3.3, BAYWIDE POLICY No. 37, FOR REVISIONS TO THE NOTICE AND HEARING PROCESS FOR AMENDING THE PLAN

The City of Coos Bay ordains as follows:

Section 1. Volume I, Part 1, Chapter 8.3, Land Use and Community Development Planning, Strategies, LU.1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

LU.1 The City of Coos Bay shall create a procedure for public hearings which will be contained in the Land Development Ordinance and which shall comply with the requirements of Statewide Planning Goal 1, Citizen Participation, to provide the opportunities and procedures whereby the general public may be involved in the City's on-going land-use planning process.

Section 2. Volume III, Part 1, Chapter 3.3, Baywide Policy #37, Plan Revisions and Amendments, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Policy #37 <u>PLAN REVISIONS AND AMENDMENTS</u> (Amended Per Resolutions 84-4 & 84-5, 4/23/84)

The City of Coos Bay shall create a procedure for public hearings which will be contained in the Land Development Ordinance and which shall comply with the requirements of Statewide Planning Goal 1, Citizen Participation, to provide the opportunities and procedures whereby the general public may be involved in the City's on-going land-use planning process.

Section 3. Severability. The sections and subsections of this Ordinance are severable. The invalidity of one section or subsection shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections or subsections.
