

ORDINANCE NO. 60**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE METHOD AND FORM OF NOMINATION FOR ELECTIVE CITY OFFICES IN THE CITY OF COOS BAY AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 32.**

The City of Coos Bay Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Methods of Nomination. Any person possessing the qualifications required by the city charter may file for candidacy for city office by either of the following methods:

- (1) Nomination may be made by filing a declaration of candidacy accompanied by a petition containing the signatures of not less than 25 qualified voters in the city.
- (2) Nomination may be made by filing a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by a fee of \$25.00.

Section 2. Nomination Forms; Filing Period. The petition and declaration shall be on forms prescribed by the Council, examples of which are attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B." filings shall be not sooner than the 15th day after the date of the primary election and not later than the 70th day before the date of the general election, and shall be filed with the city elections officer.

Section 3. Repeal. Ordinance No. 32, enacted July 9, 1984, is repealed.
