

ORDINANCE NO. 284

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING COOS BAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ADOPTING A POLICY FOR NATURAL HAZARDS THEREFOR

The City of Coos Bay ordains as follows:

Section 1. Comprehensive Plan, Volume I, 7.1, Natural Resources and Hazards, is amended to include the following policy:

“NRH.12 Coos Bay recognizes that local and state building codes agencies require building standards that are intended to prevent collapse of structures when they are subjected to earthquake or tsunami forces (1997 Uniform Building Code, Chapter 18).”

Section 2. Emergency Declared. Because the prompt and continuous administration and enforcement of the Comprehensive Plan is necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Coos Bay, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
