

ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADVISORY ELECTIONS BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF COOS BAY; SETTING FORTH THE METHOD OF SUBMITTING THE QUESTIONS; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2715.

The City of Coos Bay Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Council May Submit; Results Not Binding. The Council may submit advisory questions to the voters of the city. Advisory questions may be used to test the opinions of the voters of the city on issues presented by the Council. The results are advisory only and have no legal binding effect.

Section 2. Election Dates. Advisory questions may be included on a ballot submitted in a general or special election.

Section 3. Election Statutes Applicable. All statutory provisions relating to notices, ballot form and general conduct of elections shall apply to advisory questions submitted to the voters of the city.

Section 4. Repeal. Ordinance No. 2715, enacted August 22, 1977, is repealed.
