ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE METHOD AND FORM OF NOMINATION FOR ELECTIVE CITY OFFICES IN THE CITY OF COOS BAY, OREGON, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 378.

The City of Coos Bay Ordains as follows:

- **Section 1. Methods of Nomination.** Any person possessing the qualifications required by the city charter may file for candidacy for city office by either of the following methods:
 - (1) Nomination may be made by filing a declaration of candidacy accompanied by a petition containing the signatures of not less than 25 qualified voters in the city.
 - (2) Nomination may be made by filing a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by a fee of \$25.00.

Section 2. Nomination Forms; Filing Period. Filing for candidacy shall conform to state law applicable to the election.
