

ORDINANCE NO. 60**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE METHOD AND FORM OF NOMINATION FOR ELECTIVE CITY OFFICES IN THE CITY OF COOS BAY, OREGON, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 378.**

The City of Coos Bay Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Methods of Nomination. Any person possessing the qualifications required by the city charter may file for candidacy for city office by either of the following methods:

- (1) Nomination may be made by filing a declaration of candidacy accompanied by a petition containing the signatures of not less than 25 qualified voters in the city.
- (2) Nomination may be made by filing a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by a fee of \$25.00.

Section 2. Nomination Forms; Filing Period. Filing for candidacy shall conform to state law applicable to the election.
