Mr. Stratford is in the process of collecting background information on the theater from city staff and the Egyptian Theatre Preservation Association and will be working in the community the week of March 19th. It is anticipated the study will be completed by the first week of June. A public presentation of the study by Mr. Stratford will be given at 5:30 p.m. June 13th in the Coos Bay Downtown Fire Hall conference room, 450 Elrod Avenue.
