Parks Master Plan Survey

PURPOSE: The City of Coos Bay is in the process of developing a Parks Master Plan. The City seeks to enrich the quality of life for the citizens of Coos Bay by offering safe, accessible, attractive park facilities. This plan will serve as a guide for the City and Parks Commission for the management of facilities over the next decade. An important part of the planning process is providing ample opportunity for community members to share their thoughts on the current park system and suggest changes that will enhance the services offered. This survey is meant to gauge public interest, behaviors, and attitudes concerning the City's parks. Results from survey responses will be used to help address parks and facility concerns in a way that will reflect the community's values and best meet its needs. The master plan process is expected to take 12 months to complete.
