Students from Marshfield High School's National Honor Society will read stories by Dr. Seuss and other favorite authors at four age-related reading stations: **Green Eggs and Ham** - Preschool, **Daisy-Head Mayzie** - Kindergarten and 1st Grade, **McElligot's Pool** - Grades 2 & 3, **Yertle the Turtle** - Grades 4,5, 6, 7,& 8.

The Friends of the Coos Bay Library and the library's state funded Ready-to-Read Grant will provide free books for drawings, which will be held throughout the evening at each of the four reading stations. Titles will include books by such favorite authors as Brian Jacques, Carl Hiaasen, Hilary McKay, Karen Cushman, Don and Audrey Wood, and many other noteworthy children's writers.

Lynda Sanders, President of the Coos Bay Education Association, will be among those volunteers who will be assisting at this event along with members of the Friends of the Coos Bay Library. The Coos Bay Education Association will also provide bookmarks, cookies, and juice. Adults are invited to enjoy tea, coffee, and cookies in the Myrtlewood Room while stories are being read.
