There were15 (fifteen) poster entries submitted for the 4th through 6th grades, and there was one essay entry submitted for the 7th through 8th grades. The entries were judged by Mayor Crystal Shoji, Councilor Stephanie Kramer, and Library Director Sami Pierson on Monday, May 6th. Lindsey Putman was chosen for the poster entry and Ashlee Guillory was chosen for the essay entry.

Both Putnam's and Guillory's entries will be submitted to the Oregon Mayors Association state-level competition at which winners will be selected at three age levels: grade school, middle school, and high school. The statewide winners will receive new laptop computers.

For those who wish to view the entries in the contest, they will be displayed at the Coos Bay Public Library for two weeks from May 8th to May 22nd.
