- Brush to be placed by curb <u>prior</u> to Tuesday, September 6, 2016.
- Brush must be in 1 pile and no more than 5 feet in length.
- Brush should be placed next to curb, free from any overhead obstacles, fire hydrants and/or other obstructions.
- 1 pile per address, NO group piles.
- No materials which are not appropriate for grinding. <u>NO</u> grass clippings, sod, dirt, loose leaves, plastic bags, baling twine, or other non-organic materials.
- Brush must not exceed 5 cubic yards. More than 5 yards can be taken, but prior arrangements must be made. Call Les' Sanitary or Coos Bay Sanitary to do this.
- \$11.50 per cubic yard additional charge during and after brush pickup.

Items to put in your pile:

- Brush
- Tree limbs
- Leaves in paper bags
- Blackberry vines

Brush pick-up is a great time to make sure your property complies with city code by keeping the streets and sidewalks clear and safe.

Coos Bay Municipal Code 8.10.060 states:

- The abutting property owner is responsible for keeping streets and sidewalks clear.
- Trees and bushes must be trimmed so that any overhanging portions are at least eight (8) feet above the sidewalk and at least fourteen (14) feet above the roadway.
- Any dead or decaying tree must be removed if it is a hazard to the public or to persons or property on or near the property.
