ISSUE: KPFF Consulting Engineers contract amendment

BACKGROUND:

The City obtained the services of KPFF Consulting Engineers to design Phase 1 of the structural renovation improvements for the Egyptian Theater in the fall of 2012 in the amount of \$37,726.95. At the January 7, 2014 Urban Renewal Agency meeting, the Egyptian Theater Preservation Association applied for a grant with the Agency, and they were awarded \$70,000 to renovate the facade along with several cosmetic improvements to the facility. The facade improvements will require structural and mechanical design; therefore, staff recommends amending KFPP Consulting Engineers contract to include the Egyptian Theater facade design not to exceed \$16,800.00.

ADVANTAGES:

Enhance the beatification of the downtown area.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:

Funding would come from the Downtown Urban Renewal District Facade Grant Program which was approved in the amount of; \$70,000.
