ISSUE: Egyptian Theater Façade Project Bids

BACKGROUND:

The City recently advertised an RFP for the Egyptian Theater façade project and received one bid; DLB Construction, Inc in the amount of \$364,241. Their bid was over the budget estimate and available funds of \$230,000. The City negotiated with DLB Construction, Inc and broke the scope into two, "A" and "B". Scope "A" includes demolition of the main entrance, ticket booth soffit, entry doors and reinstallation of new store front doors, windows, hardware, stucco exterior walls, fur – out 3" at bottom of wall to be consistent with the rest of wall and tile grout line. Scope "B" is to demolish the exsisting canopy and install the new canopy and coordinate the installation of the new marquee. Scope "B" work will commence after additional funds are secured.
