ISSUE: Façade Grant for 100 Central Avenue, Coos Bay (North Point Building)

### BACKGROUND

A façade improvement grant application was submitted by Edward Meyer and James Berg for the North Point Building. The structure is located in the Downtown Urban Renewal District on the northwest corner of Central Avenue and South Broadway at 100 Central Avenue. The building is two stories with office space on the first floor. The second floor is not occupied. The building was constructed in 1908. The current businesses that are in the building include North Point Real Estate, Edward Jones Investments, The Threads That Bind Quilt Shop, and The Studio.

The applicants are proposing to use the façade grant to replace the decorative trim on the existing awnings, repair and paint the east and south walls of the building, and then replace the decorative trim on those elevations, and finally to repair loose or damaged wood siding on south and east elevation.

On May 18, 2015, the Design Assistance Team reviewed the applicant's submittal and recommended approval of the proposed project as proposed. The proposed color scheme is "Beige" (HC172) for the building and the trim will be "Hale Navy" (HC154). The scroll on the awning and building will be a darker shade of the "Beige" used on the building.

Subject to approval by the Urban Renewal Agency, the Façade Improvement Program provides a 50/50 grant with a maximum grant award of \$25,000 per fiscal year. As required by the program, bids for the proposed façade project have been obtained. The bid totals are as follows: \$18,300, \$20,184.25 and \$21,658.

### ADVANTAGE

The façade improvements will allow the needed façade repairs to the structures and help maintain an attractive living, working, and shopping environment which will further the URA goal of curing urban blight.

## **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

Funding for the Downtown Urban Renewal Façade Improvement Program for the fiscal year 2014-2015 is \$100,000. There is currently \$56,147.00 remaining in the account.

Funding for the proposed project would be from the Downtown Urban Renewal Façade Improvement Program #57-940-520-2415 in the amount of \$9,150.00, which is 50% of the lowest obtained bid.

### **ACTION REQUESTED**

Staff is requesting the Agency award a façade improvement grant for \$9,150.00 to business owners Edward Meyer and James Berg for façade improvements as proposed at 100 Central Avenue, Coos Bay, Oregon.








