ISSUE: Streetscape Project - Revised Rendering for North Entry

SUMMARY:

The Agency requested Wes Shoger from Green Works, Inc. to revise the current north entry rendering to reflect Agency member ideas from the March 28, 2017 work session. The city will not receive the rendering until April 24, 2017, therefore it will be presented to Agency at the April 25, 2017 work session.

ACTION REQUESTED:

If council is satisfied with revisions made to the north entrance rendering, approve of rendering. Green Works, Inc. will bring the preliminary design to 100%, which will be ready for ODOT review/approval. If all goes well, construction could start in early June, 2017.

BACKGROUND:

The city is looking at improving curb appeal for the north and south entry points to the city. At the March 28, 2017 work session, Wes Shoger, from Green Works, Inc. presented proposed renderings of the north and south entry. Agency members requested modifications be made to the north entry rendering.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:

Consultant contract \$27,016.50, funding is from URA. Estimated cost for the improvements will be available when the plans are finalized.
