Board Member Muenchrath commented he was in favor of the donation, but would like to make sure of no obligations to the Astoria museum before the transfer.

Board Member Muenchrath moved to approve the donation of the Wurlitzer Pipe Organ to the Hood River History Museum with an agreement of no liabilities or costs to the Agency, and no previous obligations to the Astoria museum. Board Member Kramer seconded the motion which passed with Chair Eck and Board Members Burnette, Daily, Kramer, McKeown and Muenchrath voting aye. Board Member Gould was absent.
