Flag Salute


Chair Gene Melton opened the meeting and led the Agency and assembly in the salute to the flag.

Discussion on the Downtown Traffic Study

The work session was held to review the preliminary downtown traffic study presented by Civil West Engineering and Southern Oregon Transportation Engineering. Of concern was the movement of traffic through downtown with the goal of providing access to downtown businesses. The Agency requested Civil West Engineering and Southern Oregon Transportation Engineering to provide an analysis of changing the traffic pattern on Central to two-way and requested staff to assess the cost feasibility of moving the utilities on Central to accommodate two-way traffic. No decisions were made.
