# <u>Update on the Fire Station Siting by Fire Chief</u> Stan Gibson and Architect Joe Slack

Architect Joe Slack, HGE Inc., distributed a report on soil samplings taken for the 4<sup>th</sup> and Kruse Avenue and the 4<sup>th</sup> and Curtis Avenue sites and commented both locations would require pilings. Mr. Slack reviewed the site analysis for the potential new fire station locations at the City Hall site, 4<sup>th</sup> Street site, Curtis & 4<sup>th</sup> Street site, and Kruse & 4<sup>th</sup> Street site. There was discussion on the differences of the each site. Interim City Manager Joyce Jansen explained Chief Gibson received a time line recently at a bond and ballots workshop he attended and in order to make the ballot by May 2008 a ballot the campaign needed to start immediately. Chief Gibson's commented his first choice for the fire station would be the 4<sup>th</sup> Street site and the second choice would be the 4<sup>th</sup> and Curtis site. There was discussion on parking locations, using the location of the old fire station siting for parking, and the cost of parking spaces by the Council.

Board Member Gould moved to approve the 4<sup>th</sup> Street site for the site of the new fire hall. Board Member Burnette seconded the motion which passed with Board Members Burnette, Gould, Kramer and Muenchrath voting aye, and Board Member Daily, Eck, and McKeown voting nay.
