# MINUTES OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF THE CITY OF COOS BAY

## September 1, 1998

### Approval of the Minutes of August 20 and August 26, 1998

Board Member Miller moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Board Member Weeks seconded the motion which passed with all members present voting aye.

#### Approval of the Coos Art Museum Deed

City Attorney Randall Tosh explained the City of Coos Bay has deeded the property to the Urban Renewal Agency so that a restrictive covenant can be imposed limiting the use of the building as an art museum until such time as the City Council determines the ownership and maintenance of a public art collection is no longer in the public interest. The purpose of the change is to facilitate the Coos Art Museum's efforts to obtain grants for improvements to the facility. Board Member Miller moved to approve the deed. Board Member Weeks seconded the motion which passed with all members present voting aye.

## <u>Resolution URA 98-7 — Declaring the Necessity of Acquiring</u> <u>Certain Real Property</u>

City Attorney Randall Tosh explained the Agency has a need to acquire property located in the Front Street area to provide access into the heart of the Front Street development project. Board Member Miller moved to approve the deed. Board Member Weeks seconded the motion which passed with all members present voting aye.
